ORDINANCE NO. 2022-0425

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF AMES, TEXAS; REGULATING THE USAGE OF AMES' SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM FOR RECREATIONAL VEHICLE PARKS; AND PROVIDING A PENALTY.

Section 1

Definitions

The following words and phrases, when used in this ordinance, shall have the meanings respectively ascribed to them in this section:

Recreational vehicle, as used in this ordinance, shall mean any of the following:

Travel trailer means a vehicular, portable structure built on a chassis, designed to be used as a temporary dwelling for travel, recreational and vacation uses, or permanently identified travel trailer by the manufacturer of the trailer and, factory equipped for the road, it shall have a body width not exceeding eight feet and a body length not exceeding state maximum.

Pick-up coach means a structure designed to be mounted on a truck chassis for use as a temporary dwelling for travel, recreation and vacation. The pick-up coach shall remain on the truck chassis at all times, except for any repair or maintenance work which necessitates the pick-up coach being removed from the truck chassis, in which case such repair or maintenance work shall be completed within two days or removal.

Motor home means a portable, temporary dwelling to be used for travel, recreation and vacation, constructed as an integral part of a self- propelled vehicle.

Dependent trailer means a trailer which is dependent upon a service building for toilet and lavatory facilities.

Self-contained trailer means a trailer which can operate independent of connection to sewer, water and electric systems. It contains water-flushed toilet, lavatory, shower and kitchen sink, all of which are connected to water storage and sewage holding tanks located within the trailer.

RV Park means a single parcel of land or contiguous lots owned by the same individual, family, entity, or non-related entities, or which were previously owned by the same individual or entity and transferred, assigned, reassigned, conveyed, or reconveyed, within the last five (5) years, that shall provide a minimum of five (5) acres in area under a single ownership (as compared to a subdivision), or under control or joint control of one or more individuals, which has been planned and improved for the placement of two (2) or more Recreational vehicles, travel trailers, pick-up coaches, motor homes, dependent trailers, or self-contained trailers.

Section 2

A. Each RV Park that uses the City of Ames' sanitary sewer system must pay the monthly base rate for each sewer connection on its premises.

Section 3

A. The base sewer rate for each sewer connection in an RV Park is \$45.00.

Section 4

Any violation of this ordinance is punishable by a fine up to \$500.00. Each day that a person is noncompliant with this ordinance constitutes a separate penalty.

This ordinance takes full force and effect once signed by the mayor, attested by the city secretary, and duly published in the newspaper of record.
